- ✚ **Accept Minutes from the May 13th meeting:** The meeting began at 12:05pm with the approval of the minutes from the May meeting.
- ✚ **Welcome New Members to Committee:** Drs. Sando and Weitzel were welcomed to the committee by Dr. Meldrum and all the members.
- ✚ **Elect New Chair and Vice Chair:** The members present unanimously elected Dr. Katie Vogel-Anderson as chair and Dr. Jackie Jourjy as vice chair.
- ✚ **Update on Proposed Dress Code:** Dr. Frye was invited to attend this meeting in order to continue discussion on this topic. Dr. Frye presented the committee with a copy of the University of Tennessee, College of Pharmacy dress policy. This policy was also presented to various departments and all agreed that the document made sense. The POP and PD departments thought that scrubs should be omitted from this policy since it conflicts with the regulations of UFHealth. According to UFHealth policy, scrubs should not be worn outside of the work environment and all employees and students should change before leaving the hospital. This policy would also affect students in the HSC and HPNP buildings and would therefore cause issues with dress codes for class. The use of a clearly visible UF badge is another policy that is also being proposed as part of the dress code. The purpose of the name badge is to clearly identify students and their role to all University and hospital guests and employees. This policy was revised by the members of this committee in order to better serve the purpose of our College. Dr. Frye will present the revised policy to all departments for one last check. Once it is finalized it will be moved to the Student Council committee and maybe even the Professionalism committee. It is expected that the Student Council committee would be the one to enforce this policy with all students.
