- ✚ **Accept Minutes:** The meeting began at 1:03pm with the minutes from the February 14th meeting being accepted.
- ✚ **Understanding the Incentive Gap for PharmD/PhD Students at UF:** A PharmD student from the PC department contacted the Dean's Office and presented this document to the Associate Dean of our college. The packet explains the implications and solutions of financial concerns for students. This plan was distributed to all of the GSC members, to have them review the packet and provide feedback at our next meeting.
- ✚ **M.S.P. in Pharmaceutical Sciences Academic Assessment Plan:** The PhD plan has worked its way through the approval process.
